

Highways Report for Parish Council Meeting  
13 November 2024

Highways issues resolved over the last three months are:

- Advisory 20 mph signs have been put up in Charles Close.
- Old village sign replaced with the new WNC logo
- Road markings from the Walgrave Road crossover have been repainted.

Currently, there is work being done in Harrington Road to resolve the broken drain between The Bakery and Millers Bank.
